

Battery Warranty Coverage

Warranty registration must be completed and registered with Noblelift Canada Inc. before claims are processed.

Industrial wet cell lead acid batteries Carries a 3 Year or 6000 hours Warranty, whichever comes first.

Industrial Lithium-Ion battery for Class III product Carries a 3 Year or 6000 hours Warranty, whichever comes first.

Industrial Lithium-Ion battery for Class I, II product Carries a 10 Year or 20,000 hours Warranty, whichever comes first.

The Lithium Ion Phosphate battery is warranted to be charge and discharge normally and have a remaining capacity of 65% or higher by the end of ten years or 20,000 hours, whichever comes first. Manufacture of the Battery Management System within Lithium-Ion battery only covers their component for 5 years.

Noblelift Canada Inc. warrants each new Noblelift Battery to be free, under normal use and when the manufactures maintenance guidelines are followed, of defects in material and workmanship from the date of first use by the original purchaser from an Authorized Dealer. For the duration of the Warranty period listed for your battery model in the chart above.

Coverage

During the specified warranty period all manufactures scheduled maintenance must be performed and documented by the Authorized Selling Dealer or Factory Trained Personnel utilizing OEM original parts, any defect in material or workmanship of the warranted item shall be repaired or replaced at Noblelift's option, by an Authorized Noblelift Dealer.

Exclusions & Limitations

1. This Warranty does not cover a battery that is simply discharged or that are damaged due to abuse, neglect, misuse, collision, explosion, freezing, theft, overcharging, alteration, improper installation, use of special additives, unauthorized attempt to repair or failure to keep the battery properly maintained.
2. Failure to supply Battery maintenance records with warranty claims will result in claim being delayed or denied until records are made available.
